# Background

- According to the Economic Opportunity and Nondiscrimination Policy (the Policy):
  - 1. All developers must submit annual reports to the City of New Rochelle (the City) for review
  - 2. These reports highlight information that allows the City to monitor best efforts with the goals outlined in the Policy
  - **3.** For the year 2019, the City shared the annual reports received with Anchin in order to complete a retrospective review
    - These numbers will be discussed in our results section for comparison purposes
  - 4. For the year 2020, all annual reports were uploaded to Anchin's secure file transfer system, Huddle, for review and analysis



# Annual Reporting **Requirements**

#### Individual hiring

- Targeted Workers<sup>1</sup> and Other New Rochelle (NR) residents
  - 20% of the work hours on the project to Targeted Workers
  - Provide count of Other NR residents

#### Apprentices

1,000 hours for every 20,000 construction hours performed by a Prime Contractor and its subcontractors of any tier

#### Non-construction employment

- Targeted Workers
  - 25% of the available jobs on the project

qualified and/or trained worker referred to a Construction Contractor or Employer by the First Source Referral Center, either for the currently A NCHIN available position, or for any position within the previous twelve months.



# Annual Reporting Requirements

#### Construction Contracts

- NR businesses developer obligation
  - 10% of prime contracts for construction work
- NR businesses prime obligation
  - 20% of the dollar value of subcontracts for construction work
- Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises (MWBEs)<sup>2</sup>
  - Provide outreach

#### Services Contracts

- NR businesses
  - 20% of the dollar value of service contracts

MWBEs

#### Provide outreach

(2) A business that is at least 51% owned by one or more individuals who are African American, Hispanic American, Native American, Asian-Pacific 🖉



# Anchin Process

- Conducted introductory presentations with all developers
- Set up Huddle accounts for receipt of annual reports
- Completed an initial review of the reports
- Followed up with those who were missing information
- Developed analysis spreadsheet
  - Worker count, hours and percent complete
  - Project start date, completion date and certification tracking




## **Overview**

- The City provided Anchin with a list of 38 total project sites. Of those sites:
  - Pre-construction 17
  - Under Construction 10
  - Completed 11
- We received annual reports for 35 total job sites
- Of those, 16 sites were in the pre-construction phase, 10 were under construction and 9 were completed
- Anchin performed a review of all annual reports received and analyzed the data provided for those with workers on-site




## **Results – Targeted Workers On-Site (Hours) – Individual Hiring**



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# Results – Other NR Residents On-Site (Count) – Individual Hiring




Total other NR residents – 105

- 2020 Annual Reporting
  - Targeted Workers (count) 25% goal
    - ➤ Total workers 175
    - ➤ Total targeted workers 4
    - Percentage of targeted workers on-site 2%
  - Other NR Residents (count) no goal specified. The developers are required to report the number of other NR residents on-site.
    - ➤ Total workers 175
    - ➤ Total other NR residents 23
    - Percentage of other NR residents on-site 13%






# Results – Prime Contracts Awarded to NR Businesses (Developer Obligation)


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# Results – Dollar Value of Contracts Awarded to NR Businesses (Prime Obligation)



No goal specified - required to provide outreach to MWBEs





  - Total dollar value of services contracts -\$4,938,611



No goal specified - required to provide outreach to MWBEs

### **Recommendations**

#### Continue to:

- Increase awareness of the policy to the developers
- Drive the importance of compliance and good faith efforts
- Provide clarity regarding the developers' obligations under the policy
- Work with the developers that are falling short of compliance goals
- Use the Anchin/First Source Referral Center informational package as a resource for developers
- Communicate the importance of accurate numbers and completeness of reports



### **Recommendations**

In the future, Anchin recommends that the City:

- Conduct mandatory training sessions for the developers to ensure that they are aware of the proper reporting techniques
- Annually review the list of City of NR businesses
  - Create an online database for the developers reference.
    This database should be searchable and available to the public
  - Include North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes
  - Note self-identifying MWBEs



### **Recommendations**

- Encourage construction companies to register as MWBEs
- Annually review good faith efforts
- Edit the Policy to ensure clarity and compliance to the reporting requirements
  - Define services vs. non-construction
  - Clarify what is meant by "New Apprentices" or remove "New" to avoid confusion
  - Explain that MWBEs do not need to be state certified
  - Note that that are no specific wage requirements or wage reporting requirements
  - Define certified payroll
  - Add due dates for Quarterly and Annual Reporting



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
