


Overview

Results – Targeted Workers On-Site (Hours) vs. Other NR Residents On-Site (Count) – Individual Hiring





Goal: 1,000 hours for every 20,000 construction hours




Results – Targeted Workers On-Site vs. Other NR Residents On-Site (Count) – Non-construction




Results – Prime Contracts Awarded to NR Businesses (Developer Obligation)

Results – Dollar Value of Contracts Awarded to NR Businesses (Prime Obligation)




Results – MWBEs (Construction Contracts)


Results – NR Businesses - Services Contracts

- The IDA invested in MWBE resources
 - We see positive correlations from this investment in the 2021 annual reporting results
- The IDA amended the Uniform Tax Exemption Policy to create a community investment fund to incubate and accelerate MWBEs
- The City has additional plans for 2022 to further drive compliance with the Policy's goals
- The City has invested in a vocational training and business accelerator program to connect local residents and MWBEs to jobs and contracting opportunities
